



Update for Residents of Caleb Village in Kindersley February 8, 2021

Caleb Village in Kindersley has resumed all services – dining room, bistro, activities, and transit.

Residents began to receive their COVID-19 vaccination (dose 1) on Saturday, February 6th, 2021. We appreciate being included in Phase 1 of the Provincial Vaccination Plan. The remaining residents will be vaccinated once the region receives more vaccine, hopefully in the next month.

Visitors are restricted for compassionate reasons only. Those visits must be scheduled by calling the front desk at 306-463-3104. There are limited visitation times available each week. We encourage families to connect by phone, facetime or zoom to stay in contact with loved ones.

Restrictions and service closures are subject to change without notice – by taking immediate action, we can stop the spread of COVID-19.

We would like to remind everyone to continue to follow the provincial guidelines and Public Health Orders: stay home if unwell, call 811 to arrange for testing, wash your hands, wear a mask, no visitors to your household (unless a single person only visits your household), limit travel to essential medical travel only and limit shopping – order online if possible. Together we can get through this pandemic.
