

Caleb Village in Saskatchewan: The Path Forward (Our Re-opening Plan)

As of July 12th, 2021

Allowing visitation without booking an appointment, removing screening forms, and adding testing to our screening protocols.

1. Residents
 1. We highly encourage residents to get vaccinated. Over 95% of our residents have received both vaccinations.
 2. We highly encourage the use of a mask while on the main floor.
 3. Mask use required when using transit services.
2. Visitors
 1. Please sign in when visiting. Screening forms have been removed.
 2. We would like you to wear a mask for the protection of our residents and our employees.
 3. Unlimited number of visitors, no need to book an appointment. Visits to take place in the suite or outside only.
 4. Overnight visitation allowed as of July 12th.
 5. No access to the Bistro, dining room or main floor yet.
 6. Please volunteer for our Antigen Testing Program, to continue to keep COVID-19 out of the building and prevent any further restrictions.
3. Contractors
 1. Please sign in when entering the building. Screening forms have been removed.
 2. Mask use required.
 3. Voluntary antigen testing begins the week of July 12th.
4. Staff
 1. Mandatory mask use while at work.
 2. The screening forms to still be completed with temperature checks.
 3. Voluntary antigen testing begins the week of July 12th.
5. Salon
 1. Salon clients can go directly to the Salon without waiting outside.
 2. Salon appointments should remain as is with different days for outside clients.

COVID-19 continues to be a threat to those who are unvaccinated. We highly recommend that everyone receives both vaccinations to continue to protect our residents and staff.

These restrictions are subject to change without notice.

Caleb Village will continue to work closely with the Saskatchewan Health Authority on any suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19, which may include testing, monitoring and or further restrictions to control the spread of COVID-19.
