



Update for Employees of Caleb Village in Saskatchewan – November 12, 2020

Yesterday we were advised that Caleb Village in North Battleford has a confirmed outbreak of COVID-19. There are 3 residents that have tested positive for COVID-19 and 51 residents that are being isolated until test results are received.

Employee's of Caleb Village have the appropriate PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) available to them to use during this unprecedented time. If your facility is under an Outbreak status, then all staff must be tested for COVID-19.

The health and wellbeing of our residents and our employee's is our primary concern. We ask that all employee's continue to follow the guidelines of the Saskatchewan Health Authority – wash your hands (many times during the day), wear a mask while at work, and follow the necessary PPE guidelines if Caleb Village is under an outbreak status. We also ask our employees to limit unnecessary travel in and out of your community, keep your circle small, refrain from attending gatherings and wear a mask when in public.

We know this has not been easy, and we appreciate all that you do to provide a safe place for our residents.
