



COVID-19 OUTBREAK DECLARED AT

Caleb Village in North Battleford, Saskatchewan

NOVEMBER 12, 2020

Yesterday we were advised that Caleb Village in North Battleford has a confirmed outbreak of COVID-19. There are 3 residents that have tested positive for COVID-19 and 51 residents that are being isolated until test results are received. These 54 residents are unable to leave their suite or the building. The remaining 50 residents have also been asked to remain in their suites and refrain from leaving the building for at least 2 weeks, or until such time as the outbreak is declared over by the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA).

Testing begins today for all residents and employees of Caleb Village – North Battleford. Visitors are restricted to those visiting for compassionate reasons only. All activities within the building have been cancelled, including access to the Bistro. The dining room is closed, and meals are being delivered. Families are encouraged to reach out to their loved ones through technology during this time.
